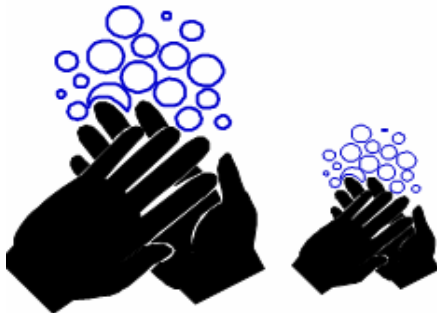


2008 DIAPER CHANGING Procedure

(Childcare Centers- NOV 2008)



- 1) **Gather** supplies before placing child on diapering surface.
- 2) **Put on disposable gloves**(recommended)
- 3) Use Baby wipe to clean child, wiping front to back.
- 4) **Dispose** of soiled wipes, diaper, and gloves.
- 5) **Clean** your hands with wipe and put on gloves(recommended).
- 6) **Place a clean diaper under child**, applying diapering products, if needed, using tissue. Dispose of tissue.
- 7) Remove gloves and dress child.
- 8) **Wash** child's hands or use Baby wipe if child is unable to support her or his head. Dry the child's hands and return the child to a supervised area.
- 9) **Spray** entire diapering surface with soapy water solution and wipe clean, using a disposable paper towel.
- 10) **Spray** entire diapering surface with **DISINFECTANT** (surface must be glistening wet) and allow to air dry for at least 2 minutes (chlorine) or as specified on disinfectant label.
- 11) **Wash your hands.**
