Operations



Purpose

- To initiate and develop a successful Men's 3 on 3 Basketball program in Anson County.
- To encourage fair play, good sportsmanship, and teamwork in participants, including, but not limited to, players, coaches.
- To establish a Men's 3 on 3 Basketball environment that welcomes community involvement, which is essential to ensuring the long-term success of the Men's 3 on 3 Basketball program.

**I. General League Rules**

- 1. All players must be 18 or older. One player can be between 14 – 18.**
- 2. Each team shall consist of no more than (3) players and (1) substitute.**
- 3. There will be no officials, or clock and teams will keep their own score and call own fouls.**
- 4. There will be no shooting fouls; the ball will be taken out on all fouls.**
- 5. Only 3 players are allowed to play at one time.**
- 6. Games will be best 2 out of 3.**
- 7. Teams who win 2 games will be declared the winner and that team will be given 1 win in the standings.**
- 8. If a team has only 2 players to show, they are allowed to pick up a player from one of the other teams. This means No Outsiders.**
- 9. Players can be on only 1 team's roster**
- 10. Games will start on April 5, 2004 at the Wadesboro Elem. Gym**
- 11. Cost is \$22.00 per player.**
- 12. The deadline for Fee and Roster is Friday, April 2, 2004.**
- 13. Teams are responsible for contacting the recreation department about wins by the next day.**
- 14. If opposing team shoots and hits nothing, you may put back. If opposing shot hits rim or backboard you must take back to the foul line.**
- 15. Players must be full time employees/ student (25 hours / week) with the exception of the 14 – 18 year olds must be full time student.**
- 16. Game will not be make it take it. The game will be played on alternating possessions.**
- 17. 2 point shot will count as 2 points and 3 point shots will count as 3 points.**
- 18. Games will be played to 20.**
- 19. End of Season Tournament will be optional.**
- 20. Games will be played on Mondays and Thursdays**
- 21. Games will start at 6:00pm on respective days.**
- 22. Red and Blue Vest will be provided as Uniforms.**

VI. Players and Coaches Code of Conduct

1. No player or coach shall refuse to abide by an official's decision.
2. No player or coach shall be guilty of objectionable displays of dissent at an official's decision.
3. No player or coach shall use verbal abuse upon any official, gym personnel, director, participant, or spectator.
4. No player or coach shall be guilty of using unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of the game.
5. No one shall discuss with an official the decision reached by such official except for the head coach.
6. No smoking is allowed in the gym by coaches.
7. No player, coach or spectator shall use profanity upon any official, gym personnel, director, spectator or other players.
8. No player, coach or spectator shall taunt excessively upon any official, gym personnel, director, spectator or other players.

Violations of 1 - 8 will result in ejection from the gymnasium and Rule III, b of the general league rules will also apply. Repeated violations will result in suspension for the remainder of the season. The Players and Coaches Code of Conduct has been approved by Anson County Parks and Recreation Department, Anson County Recreation Commission and the Anson County Board of Commissioners.
