

Players and Coaches Code of Conduct

- 1. No player or coach shall refuse to abide by an official's decision.**

- 2. No player or coach shall be guilty of objectionable displays of dissent at an official's decision.**

- 3. No player or coach shall use verbal abuse upon any official, gym personnel, director, participant, or spectator.**

- 4. No player or coach shall be guilty of using unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of the game.**

- 5. No smoking at any indoor facility by coaches or players.**

- 6. No player, coach or spectator shall use profanity upon any official, personnel, director, spectator or other players.**

- 7. No player, coach or spectator shall taunt any official, personnel, director, spectator or other players.**

- 8. No player, coach or spectator shall touch any official, personnel, director, spectator or other coaches. This will result in suspension and possible charge of assault will be taken.**

Violations of 1 - 8 will result in ejection from the game. The second violation will result in suspension for the remainder of the season. During suspension, you cannot attend either as a coach or a spectator your team's next game.
