**Operations**



*Purpose*

- To initiate and develop a successful T-Ball program in Anson County.
- To encourage fair play, good sportsmanship, and teamwork in participants, including, but not limited to, players, coaches and parents.
- To establish a T-Ball environment that welcomes community involvement, which is essential to ensuring the long-term success of the T-Ball program.

I. THE GAME

- a. Must be 4 by Jan. 1, but cannot be 7 before Aug. 1 of current year.
- b. 1 hour time limit.
- c. Score will not be kept.
- d. Each team will bat all players each inning, even if 3 outs occur.  
Example: Team A has 14 players and Team B has 12. Team A will bat all 14 players in every inning, Team B will bat all 12. Outs will be played as regular baseball, but will not decide the change of an inning.
- e. All players will play on defense.
- f. *Batters will have 5 swings off the tee to put the ball in play or the next batter will hit. Revision 3-30-2004***
- g. A batted ball must go past the (10') arc in front of home plate to be considered a fair ball.
- h. Each team shall bat the same amount of innings.
- i. Coaches allow players to rotate and play different positions.
- j. Always instruct and help players understand what they should be doing.
- k. Batters that throw their bats after a swing will be out and the next batter will hit.
- l. Always remember this is Tee-Ball!!!!
- l. A player must be 5 years old in order to play defense in the infield.

## Players and Coaches Code of Conduct

1. No player or coach shall refuse to abide by an official's decision.
2. No player or coach shall be guilty of objectionable displays of dissent at an official's decision.
3. No player or coach shall use verbal abuse upon any official, director or participant.
4. No player or coach shall be guilty of using unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of the game.
5. No one shall discuss with an official the decision reached by such official except for the head coach.
6. No smoking or profanity is allowed by coaches.

Violations of 1-6 will result in ejection from the field. Repeated violations will result in suspension for the remainder of the season.

The Anson County Recreation Commission Board Members, Anson County Parks and Recreation Department and the Anson County Board of Commissioners have approved the player and coach's code of conduct.

**I have read and understood the rules and the code of conduct. I understand that not following the rules and the code of conduct shall be detrimental to recreational youth programs. I shall adhere to these rules and the Code of Conduct. At anytime that I do not follow Anson County Parks and Recreation's program rules or code of conduct rules, I understand that my status as coach shall be relinquished at will.**
